1. Brown Aveda Institute has signed and returned to the Department of Education the Certificate and Agreement and intends to use or had used no less than 50% of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
2. Funds received by Brown Aveda Institute: \$181,260.00
3. Funds distributed to students by Brown Aveda Institute: \$181,260.00
4. Estimated number of eligible students: 244
5. Number of students who received Emergency Financial Aid Grants: 153
6. Students who were enrolled on 3/18/2020 when Brown Aveda Institute temporarily closed due to COVID-19 were eligible to submit an application. Students who returned the application and certified that they had expenses related to the disruption of classes due to COVID-19 and were Title IV eligible received grants. Grant funds were divided equally among students who submitted applications certifying need and eligibility.
